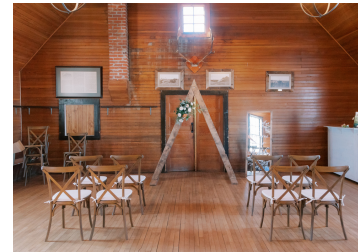
EVENT PRICING

We provide flexible rates to suit your budget, with a \$500 damage deposit required for all rentals. A non-refundable booking deposit is essential to secure your date for daily and weekend rentals. Our maximum capacity is 90 guests.



WEEKEND \$1000

This option offers facility access from Friday 8 AM to Sunday 4 PM, ideal for events requiring early setup and extended cleanup, commonly chosen for weddings.



DAILY \$400

This option gives you access to the facility from 8 AM until 11 PM.



HOURLY \$50/HR

Having an event that will only be a few hours? An hourly rate may be the best way to go. Hourly rentals have a minimum charge of three hours.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

If you plan on serving alcohol there are two additional things that you need to secure.

PARTY AND ALCOHOL LIABILITY INSURANCE

Renters with alcohol at their event must have Party and Alcohol Liability insurance (PAL). This safeguards both the host and the venue. PAL insurance can be secured through various insurance brokers or online retailers like Duuo. Please include the Jumping Pound Community Hall Society as a co-insurer when getting this coverage.

LIQUOR LICENSES

In Alberta, a special event liquor license is required for alcohol service. You can buy one from liquor stores or online via the AGLC website. The license must be displayed at the bar. Renters are required to supply their alcohol, mixers, and ice. No one under 18 may consume alcohol. Certified bartenders are recommended for your event.
